They are doing this by signing the SKILLS PLEDGE, a voluntary gesture, but one that represents a corporate commitment of support. The general purpose of the Pledge is to ensure that all staff are skilled, competent in what they do and able to make a full contribution to the success of the organisation.

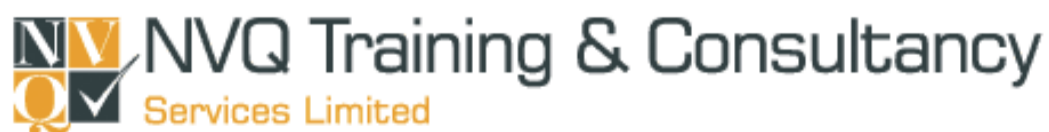

For employees who do not already have a full level 2 qualification*, the Learning & Skills Council (through the Train to Gain scheme) will provide funding to help them gain basic literacy and numeracy as well as their first Level 2 qualification.
